RE: Re-development of the Alice Springs Desert Park Courtyard

As you would be aware the Alice Springs Desert Park is undergoing some exciting new changes that will make visitor's experience of the Park more enjoyable. These changes include the re-development of the main Courtyard and the inclusion of the *Red Centre Way - The West Macs Discovery Centre*.

As of Monday 28 June 2010, extensive building works will commence in the Exhibition Centre and during this construction stage the 'Changing Heart' film will relocate to the Nocturnal House. The film will run on the half hour between 8am and 5.30pm. The film is expected to relocate to the Exhibition Centre in September.
